

Music from Spotify on Linux

You can download music from spotify albums on Linux easily, with **spotDL**

spotDL finds songs from Spotify playlists on YouTube and downloads them - along with album art, lyrics and metadata.

Tested on Ubuntu 22.04 GNU/Linux. Info derived from:

It doesn't seem to work on Ubuntu 24.04

Install spotdl & FFmpeg



```
#sudo apt install pip-check-reqs python3-full # this will install python-pip
requirements also, in case you don't have them installed yet on Ubuntu 24.04
sudo pip install spotdl
sudo apt install ffmpeg
```

Usage



```
spotdl [urls]
```

You can download complete Albums, Lists and single songs also.
